

SCHEDULING BAND WITHIN THE 4 X 4 ACADEMIC PLAN

Revised 3.1.10

For each academic year, there are 8 “slots” that are to be filled with classes, 4 classes per semester. Band will be 1 of the “slots” each semester, with the other classes listed to be distributed as desired. PLEASE NOTE THAT BAND IS A FULL YEAR COURSE (36 Weeks). There are two models shown: one shows an example of a student enrolled in band and no sports or athletics, and another that shows a student enrolled in both band and sports or athletics. The models shown below are only examples, and do have some flexibility, but illustrate typical plans that will insure the required graduation credits are completed. Parentheses show credits, including dual credits, received for that band class. *For specific questions or problems, please see your student’s individual counselor at Marcus.*

ONE of the three of these courses may be completed in the following ways: Summer School, LISD Online eSchool Course, or in rare cases, Credit by Acceleration.
